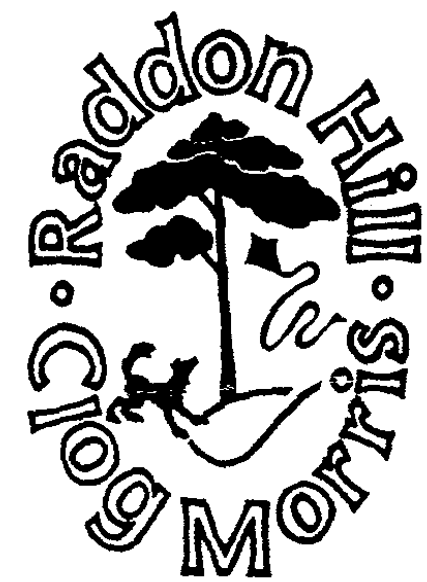
We dance in the North West Tradition, which originated in the cotton mills and factories of the North West of England.

The dances were practiced by the factory workers and were danced on feast days, carnivals and holidays.

Our costume is representative of the working clothes that were worn up to the 1930s. The men would have worn bowler hats and waistcoats and the ladies long flowing skirts. Both wore hard wearing clogs.

The name "Raddon Hill" originates from a landmark near Shobrooke, Crediton, where the side was formed.

From October to April we practice at Ide Village hall, near Exeter, on Tuesday evenings from 8 pm until 10 pm (Not the first Tuesday in the month). A warm welcome awaits any new dancer or musician.
