

A BRIEF HISTORY

Raddon Hill Clog Morris was founded in 1991 and the name is taken from a prominent landmark hill called 'Raddon Hill' near Shobrooke, Crediton where the group was first formed.

We dance in the North West Style of Morris dancing which originated in the cotton mills and factories of the North West of England. Most of the dances are named after the town or village they originated in. The dances were practiced by the factory workers and were performed on special occasions such as feast days, carnivals and public holidays. The dances use everyday items from the cotton mills such as wooden bobbins and plaited cords which have been decorated for the benefit of the performance. Our costume is representative of the working clothes that were worn until the 1930s in the cotton mills. The men would have worn bowler hats and waistcoats. The ladies would have worn long flowing skirts. Both wore hard wearing traditional clogs.

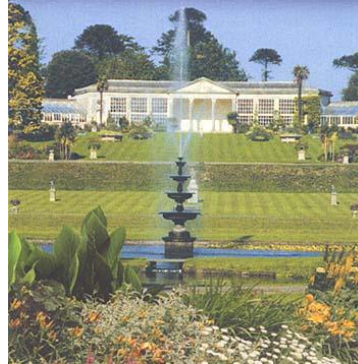
